RESOLUTION
TO PROVIDE IMPROVEMENTS TO FACILITIES TO COMPLY
WITH THE ILLINOIS ACCESSIBILITY CODE
DISTRICT-WIDE

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Community College District #508, (CCC) pursuant to the Illinois Accessibility Code, 71 Illinois Administrative Code 400.110 et.seq. and the Environmental Barriers Act, 410 ILCS 25/et.seq. is authorized to provide improvements to address the accessibility to programs and services provided by CCC; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to repair and alter certain facilities of CCC and

WHEREAS, CCC, by this resolution specifically identifies the following projects eligible for State ADA Grant Funds, for repairs or alterations; and

WHEREAS, those projects recommended for repair and alteration are:

- a. Malcolm X College – Elevator modifications
- b. Malcolm X College West Side Learning Center – Toilet room modifications.
- c. Kennedy-King College Dawson Technical Institute – Toilet room modifications.
- d. Olive-Harvey College South Chicago Learning Center – Toilet room modifications.
- e. Truman College – Elevator modifications.
- f. Truman College Lakeview Learning Center – Provisions for accessible parking; toilet room modifications. and

WHEREAS, the CCC certifies the projects meet the criteria of the ADA-Access for All Grant and brings CCC into compliance with the Illinois Accessibility Code, and the Environmental Barriers Act.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Community College District #508, as follows:

1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.
2. The physical facilities described in the projects set forth above require alterations to improve access to programs and services by students, faculty and staff of CCC.
3. There are not sufficient funds available in the Operation and Maintenance Fund of CCC to complete the projects set forth above.
4. Properly completed application forms will be completed and forwarded to the President/CEO of the ICCB for approval of the above-referenced projects prior to release of funding.
