The National Gallery of Art <https://www.nga.gov/> in Washington, DC is one of national museums on the National Mall. NGA Images is a repository of more than 51,000 digital open access images from the collections of the National Gallery of Art. On this website researchers may search, browse, share, and download images. Digital images are available free of charge for download and use. Users do not need to contact the Gallery for authorization to use these images. NGA Images is designed to facilitate learning, enrichment, enjoyment, and exploration. The collections include fine art such as the Vincent van Gogh Self-Portrait and realia such as this 20<sup>th</sup> century foot stool. This collection may be used by faculty and students to illustrate a presentation or paper.



### Featured Database of the Month

*CINAHL with Full Text* is part of the Ebsco family of databases and shares the same interface. It is the database for nursing and allied health literature. It is useful for nursing students and others in the allied health fields. Topics covered include nursing, biomedicine, health sciences librarianship, alternative/complementary medicine, and consumer health. CINAHL has the full text of the publications of the National League for Nursing and the American Nurses Association. Materials covered include scholarly and popular articles, health care books, nursing dissertations, selected conference proceedings, standards of practice, audiovisuals, and more. Ebsco offers several versions of CINAHL and other health science databases, but *CINAHL with Full Text* is the only one we subscribe to.
