



Book Rental Program FAQ

What is the CCC Online Bookstore rental program?

The CCC Online Bookstore partnered with Nebraska Book Company to increase availability of low-cost rental options. The new rental program offers students a way to save money by allowing them to rent books for a certain period of time, rather than having to purchase them. Many students purchase their books and then try to sell them back at the end of the semester—rental eliminates the need to sell books back at the end of the term.

Where can I find books to rent?

All rental options will be shown side-by-side with new, used, marketplace and eBook inventory when available.

How long does the rental term last?

Students can choose to rent their books for the following terms: Fall (July 1-December 31), Spring (December 1-May 31), or Summer (April 1-July 31).

How will rentals be priced?

Costs will vary depending on availability and length of the rental period, but we estimate that rental books will be 30-70% off original list price.

Can I use my Financial Aid when I rent a book?

Yes, all transactions will go through TextbookX.com, just as they would if you were purchasing a new or used book. Please note, when renting a book, a credit card or debit card must be provided even when using a financial aid book voucher. The card will not be charged if the book is returned on time. Prepaid cards are not accepted to back a rental order.
