

How to Apply to the MXC Radiography Program

Part I: Complete These Steps First

1. Apply to the College

If you are not already an MXC student, submit an application to the college.

2. Meet with Your Academic Advisor

Inform your assigned advisor that you intend to apply to this program.

3. Complete Prerequisite Courses

You must finish **all prerequisite courses (three) before applying:**

1. **Mathematics 118 (or higher)**

2. **Biology 116**

3. **HEAPRO 102**

Substitutions:

○ Biology 226 *or* Biology 227 may substitute for Biology 116

○ Biology 120 may substitute for HEAPRO 102

4. Submit Transcripts

○ Send all **non-CCC official transcripts** (any other colleges or universities outside of the City Colleges of Chicago) to the Malcolm X College Registrar.

○ Be aware, it takes several or more weeks to have your non-CCC transcripts evaluated **which could delay the application process.**

5. Submit Your Program Application

Apply through the Student Portal: **my.ccc.edu**

Part II: After You Apply

- An **admission specialist** will review your application to confirm you meet all requirements and deadlines.
- If you qualify, you will be emailed a **Radiography Application package**. Below is an example of what you will receive if you meet the qualifications:

- **Read the entire package carefully** and follow all instructions provided.
 - **A link is provided within the application where you will upload the essay.**
