How to register:

- **Go to Room 2424**
Mon -Thurs, 9:00 am - 6:30 pm
Fri –Sat, 9am - 12pm
- **Bring proof that you live in Illinois***
(for example a driver's license, State ID, Consular ID, utility bill, or mail)
A Social Security number is NOT required, but visitors, international students (I-20) and other non-immigrant visa holders are not eligible to enroll.
- **Fill out a registration card**
- **Get appointments** for placement testing and registration, as needed.
- **Classes start on March 9, 2015**

ESL Classes in March:

- All schedules at Lakeview and other off-campus sites

- All weekday schedules – morning, afternoon, evening

Eligibility:

- New students must verify residency in Illinois. *
- A social security number is NOT required.
- 16 and 17 year-olds may register with an official release letter certifying that they are no longer attending high school.
- Adult Education classes are intended for people who live in or near Chicago. International (I-20) students and those who have F1, F2, H1, J1, or J2 visas are not eligible to enroll in adult education classes, nor are short-term visitors to the U.S.

Rules of Attendance:

- You must start coming to class during the first three days of class. The teacher cannot accept any students who are absent all of the first three days.
- If you are absent more than five consecutive days of class, you will be dropped from the list.
- Please choose your class time carefully. Classes are very full and it is often impossible to change your schedule after registration. No class changes are permitted after the second week of class.
- **Students: You can help us keep our free program strong by coming to class every day and by taking the progress tests. This will also help you learn better and faster. Thank you for your help!**

***Residency verification – preferred documents:**

- *Driver's license or State of Illinois ID*
- *Voter registration card*
- *Copy of lease or mortgage statement*
- *Utility (water, electric, gas, or home telephone) bill*
- *Consular ID card*
- *Signed letter on letterhead from a homeless shelter confirming residency in the shelter*
- *Current orders or a letter from Command for military service persons*
