



Selective Service Verification Form

Federal law requires men age 18 through 25 to register with the Selective Service System. The Department of Education was unable to verify your Selective Service registration or exemption. You must resolve any conflicts regarding your Selective Service status before being awarded Federal Student Aid.

What you should do:

Please submit the document that makes a true statement of your circumstances. If requested, attach a copy of the documentation that supports the statement:

1. I was born female - please update the gender question on your FAFSA. (For questions call Selective Service 1-888-6551825)
2. I am under the age of 18 and not yet required to register
3. I was born before January 1, 1960
4. I am a veteran of active duty in the U.S. armed forces (do not count guard and reserves). Attach a copy of your discharge letter (DD214). If you need to obtain a copy of your DD214, please call the Veterans Administration at 1800-827-1000
5. I am registered with the Selective Service. Attach documentation of your registration status. You can obtain your registration status by logging onto the Selective Service web page <https://www.sss.gov/Home/Verification>
6. I am not registered, but I have received a Status Letter from the Selective Service. Attach a copy of your Status Letter
7. I entered the United States for the first time after my 26th birthday. Attach copies of immigration documents such as a date-stamped passport, visa, or I-94. A Resident Alien Card (Green Card) is **NOT** valid proof of entry
8. I entered the United States before age 26 on a valid non-immigrant visa, and remained in that status until age 26. Attach a date-stamped copy of your visa. A Certificate of Naturalization or Resident Alien Card (Green Card) is **NOT** valid proof of entry
9. None of the above accurately describes my situation. Attach an appeal (see directions below) that explains why you did not register

Selective Service Appeal

Write a personal statement that explains the circumstances related to your non-registration. Include your student ID number, signature and date on the appeal. If the appeal is for a reason other than being under the age of 18, you will also need to obtain a status information letter from Selective Service.
