

2021-2022 Independent Student Illinois Residency Verification Form

The Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) requires that in order for a dependent student to qualify for the Illinois Monetary Award ("MAP GRANT"), the applicant must be a resident of Illinois. We are required to secure documentation from you to verify your Illinois residency. According to your legal state of residence, please complete the following questions and attach the appropriate documentation.

According to your Illinois residency, please submit one of the following acceptable forms:

- 1. Valid State of Illinois tax return or federal tax transcript
- 2. Illinois high school or college transcript
- 3. Illinois driver's license
- 4. Utility or rent bills in the applicant's (or parent's) name
- 5. Illinois auto registration card
- 6. Residential lease in the applicant's (or parent's) name
- 7. Wage and tax statements (IRS Form W-2)
- 8. Statement of benefits history from the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services
- 9. State of Illinois identification card, issued by the Secretary of State
- 10. Statement of benefits from the Illinois Department of Employment Security
- 11. Statement of benefits from the Social Security Administration
- 12. Illinois voter's registration card
- 13. Property tax bill
- 14. IRS Form 1099 Miscellaneous Income Statements

What you should do:

1. Clearly print the student's name and student ID number on every page of 8 ½ x 11 legible copies. Please scan your documents and attach them to this form when you submit. Please submit all documents at the same time.
