

Safety and Security is available 24 hours a day to foster a safe and secure environment for all City College students, staff, and visitors.

Olive-Harvey College and the South Chicago Learning Center are staffed with over 60 security officers, most whom are current or former law enforcement officers.

IMPORTANT TO KNOW

In Case of Emergency, Call 9-911 from any CCC telephone or 911 from any cell phone, to get prompt Police (CPD) or Fire-Ambulance (CFD) response.

Then, notify Campus Security (773) 291-6780 to mobilize campus emergency resources as well.

- ✓ Program cell phone to speed dial 911, for emergencies.
- ✓ Program cell phone to speed dial the Campus Security number, (773) 291-6780.

Property Safety

- ✓ Never leave personal belongings unattended, anytime, anywhere.
- ✓ Do not leave electronic devices unattended while charging.
- ✓ Download the phone locator app for your cell phone.
- ✓ Register your bicycle with CPD and record the serial number.
- ✓ Always lock your bicycle with a secure lock to a secure location.
- ✓ Lock your vehicle and place valuables in the trunk.

Reporting of Crime

The faculty, staff, and students of Olive- Harvey College and South Chicago Learning Center are requested to report all criminal activity, suspicious persons or emergencies they encounter to Campus Safety and Security. At South Chicago Learning Center the Security Desk is staffed twenty-four hours a day and can be reached by telephone at (773)291-6780 or at ext. 6780 from any telephone on the Olive – Harvey/South Chicago Learning Center College network.

The officer, who is dispatched to the scene of an incident, will notify the Chicago Police or Fire Department, as needed. IN AN EMERGENCY CALL 911 FIRST. Each reported incident will be thoroughly investigated and documented by the officer using the City Colleges of Chicago's incident reporting system. Campus Safety and Security at Olive-Harvey College maintains a Daily Crime Log in the Security Office, Room 1109 and at the South Chicago Learning Center Security Desk as mandated by the Clery Act. The Daily Crime Log contains information regarding criminal incidents or alleged criminal incidents reported to Campus Safety & Security. The Daily Crime Log is updated daily and is available for inspection by students, faculty, staff and visitors any time during normal campus operating hours.
