As a City Colleges employee who is nursing or pumping, you can expect:

- Reasonable break time to express breast milk for your nursing infant
- A private, secure space in close proximity to your work area, other than a bathroom, where you can express breast milk

City Colleges Lactation Room Locations

District Office at 180 N. Wabash

LACTATION ROOM:

Third floor of the 180 N. Wabash building. There is an exterior keypad lock and an additional interior swipe pad that lets others know the room is occupied.

PROCESS:

Ask for assistance at the second-floor security desk for access to the room.

PROCESS:

Ask for assistance at the security desk (first floor lobby) for access to the lactation room.

PROCESS:

Room R2400A is for employees only and requires a swipe card for access. Please contact Jessica Holloway, to gain access. A sign on the door of Room 1309 will let you know if the lactation room is available or occupied.

PROCESS:

LACTATION ROOM:

Main Building, Room L830

PROCESS:

Flip the sign when you are in the room to indicate the room is occupied, and flip it back when you leave.
