

## Public Notice: Nursing Program Accreditation Update

Dear Current and Prospective Students,

In March 2025, the City Colleges of Chicago School of Nursing (CCCSN) hosted the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) for a scheduled accreditation site visit. The ACEN is the accrediting body that oversees the Associate Degree of Nursing (ADN) program at CCCSN.

Following their recent Board of Commissioners meeting, the ACEN has granted the CCCSN Associate Degree of Nursing program “Continuing Accreditation with Conditions” for a two-year period, based on the 2023 ACEN Standards and Criteria. The evaluation team’s recommendations identified opportunities for quality improvement in Standards 4 and 5.

We are pleased to share that the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing program continues to maintain its nursing accreditation. CCCSN remains fully committed to delivering a high-quality education and clinical preparation experience for our students. The School of Nursing is actively addressing the recommendations provided by ACEN and will submit a Follow-Up Report by July 15, 2027. The next comprehensive evaluation visit is scheduled for Spring 2033.
