Transfer Credit Detail (excluded from the GPA calculation)

Transfer Credit Detail includes Transfer Credit, Credit by Assessment of Prior Learning, and Credit by Standardized Examination/Testing. These credits are accepted in accordance with CCC policy, are shown on the transcript, but are not included in GPA calculations. Transfer Credits are credits earned at another institution, including military. Credit by Assessment of Prior Learning and Credit by Standardized Examination/Testing are credits granted for college-level knowledge and skills acquired outside the classroom; no letter grade is assigned. Credit is only awarded when students meet or exceed a grade level of C or above.
