1. Call to order
2. Approval of Minutes from September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2025 [\[link\]](#) Simon moves to approve, Madi seconds.
3. Updates from Deans Co Cesar and Mike Johns. Lots of changes at the district level. Goal of their plan is to make cocurricular assessment easier. Four departments were selected to work on cocurricular assessment: Advising, TRIO, Transfer, Tutoring. Is there someone at district who assessment chairs should reach out to? Right now, the committee is composed of administrators- they will reach out if they need anything.
4. Gen Ed: Quantitative Literacy
  - a. Approved SLOs
    - i. Students will be able to apply quantitative and mathematical reasoning to solve problems in diverse contexts, using a variety of methods, and communicate results accurately
    - ii. Students will be able to identify, extract, and interpret relevant quantitative data from various sources to support informed decision-making and problem-solving
    - iii. Students will be able to effectively communicate quantitative information by analyzing and interpreting representations of data such as graphs, charts, and tables.
  - b. Assessment Instrument / Tool

  - b. Discussion: the use of the term "program outcome" is specific and related to the PAC process. We should try to avoid using the term. Where would we find the program outcomes that have been approved through PAC? We have a program called CIM that we use for curriculum management.
  - c. Why? Many members brought up the question of why we are doing curriculum mapping. If this isn't helpful for your department, you could go back to the 4-phase study. It could be good to think about how each department is supporting gen ed outcomes.
