3. Some respondents wrote open-ended responses to one question that applied to another (these were coded accordingly)


As we go through the slides, remember to....







WHAT EXPERIENCE DO YOU HAVE TEACHING ONLINE AT CCC?(N=548)




HOW MANY SEMESTERS HAVE YOU TAUGHT ONLINE? (N=141)






WHAT EXPERIENCE DO YOU HAVE TAKING A CLASS ONLINE? (AT CCC OR ELSEWHERE).








PERCEPTIONS OF ONLINE TEACHING SKILLS






Perceptions of Course Quality




























I AM FEARFUL THAT (FULL-TIME VS PART-TIME FACULTY)




