
Respondents

3. Some respondents wrote open-ended responses to one question that applied to another (these were coded accordingly)


As we go through the slides, remember to....










HOW MANY SEMESTERS HAVE YOU TAUGHT ONLINE?






WHAT EXPERIENCE DO YOU HAVE TAKING A CLASS ONLINE? (AT CCC OR ELSEWHERE).









PERCEPTIONS OF ONLINE TEACHING SKILLS





- Student evaluations are not a good system for feedback




- ION is not good


Perceptions of Course Quality




Comments - Perceptions of Course Quality in CCC OL (N=20)
























I AM HOPEFUL THAT (FULL-TIME VS PART-TIME FACULTY)






I AM FEARFUL THAT (CHOOSE ALL THAT APPLY.)








Anything Else- Ideas for Improvement (N=18)
