- → Meeting 1:1 with instructor (either online or face-to-face)

- → Getting outside support (family, friends)
- → Prioritizing academic work over other things in my life
- → Asking questions when something isn't clear

Subtext:

- → Finding something to say
- → Becoming comfortable with presenting myself in a formal tone
- → Thoroughly engaging with dense, previously unknown material
- → Learning something well enough to put it into my own words
- → Mastering the tedium of documentation
- → Extending a complex conversation
- → Accepting a legitimate opposition
- → Not fully resolving an issue

It's preliminary to draw conclusions....

However, seeking and obtaining adequate support from faculty, student services, & embedded tutors, and reinforcing time management skills seem like early (and not unobvious) indicators of better potential for persistence.
