
Two Questions Driving Process:


1. Are instructor and outside observers' evaluations of student juries consistent?

2. Are students demonstrating learning outcomes of different levels?

FA17: 58/62 (93.5%)

SP18: 80/90 (88.9%)

FA18: 82/84 (98%)

### **Totals**

FA17: 133/206 (64.6%)

SP18: 169/252 (67.1%)

FA18: 191/238 (80.3%)

FA18\*: 204/238 (85.7%)

### Difference by Class?

Not anymore

#### So, what are the Outcomes Results?

72/82 (88% Demo rate); 94% passed 2 or more;

8/10 failed attempts were for sight-reading

# **Ancillary Benefits:**

In SP17,  $\frac{1}{2}$  instrument juries (just 9% of total) required students to sight-read; In FA18, 25/33 (76%) required sight-reading.
